1. Central Playground

Large active playspace surfaced by tarmac

Standard games markings for sports

- Bold, graphic markings e.g. by Magic Markings, including shapes and games

2. Amphitheatre

- Focal point to edge of playground

 Semi-circular, sculpted grassy mound - Central paved performance space

- Seating terraces formed in one section, risers formed from timber railway sleepers laid vertically, treads filled with rubber surfacing to give all weather finish

3. Equipped Play Zone (omitted)

4. Climbing Wall and Creative Zone

- Geometric arrangement of feature walls, providing an animated colourful

- Climbing wall located away from main route to St. Xaviers entrance

- Climbing walls created from colour rendered walls with bouldering holds - Rubber surface to appropriate critical fall height laid as bold, patterned carpet to whole area

- Art wall incorporating fixed artwork designed by school children, e.g. large painted mural or mosaic

5. Cycling Circuits

Tarmac surfaced area with painted cycling proficiency markings

- Slopes and mounds incorporated into surfacing

6. Quiet Seating Area (omitted)

7. Eco-Gardens (7a and 7b)

- Two gardens including space to be developed by the schools, one for Patna PS and one for St. Xaviers PS

- Semi-natural areas linked by a central meeting point with shared facilities

- Shared facilities to include a large timber storage cabin with 'green roof', wooden compost bins and a greenhouse

- Natural materials, crushed stone or self-binding pathways, willow arches, hazel - Circular, covered outdoor classroom with low tables and story telling space

- Growing areas in each space including raised beds, open digging area and mini

- Space for further development by schools

8. Wilderness Area

- Closely linked to eco-gardens in character and position

- Matrix of different native and semi-native planting types

- Long grass and sown meadow areas, intersected with mown grass pathways

- Sensory trail with different textured hard surfacing - Rounded hills and hummocks for views, hide and seek

- Simple timber seating

9. Playing Field

- Grassed field with comprehensive land drainage system

Goal posts

- Painted markings

- Resin bound gravel footpath link from main playground

- School perimeter fencing acting as ball stop barrier - Barrier between Zone 7 and 8 and Zone 9

10. Radial Colour Wheel Garden - Long, linear garden wrapping round the outer perimeter of the building

- Garden divided into different colour sections

- Transition in palette of colours between each section

- Limited number of planting species used in each section for maximum colour

- Main species type to be low, evergreen shrubs, long lived perennials and bulbs - Allow paved pathway through planting from fire escape doors to classrooms

11. Courtyards 11a and 11b

- Hard surfacing forming outdoor connections between classrooms

- Simple, bold treatment and single theme for each space

- Charcoal / White Block surfacing

- Planting areas to be developed by schools

12. Nursery Play Area

- 'Secret Garden' character due to high walls enclosing spaces

- Feature 'windows' in boundary wall

- Boundary wall 'greened' with climbing plants

- Blackboards and sensory panels mounted on inside of boundary wall

- Rubber safety surfacing with strips of contrasting colours - Bird nesting boxes and feeders to encourage wildlife

13. Memory Garden

- Existing memorial tree to be relocated

- Additional specimen trees to be arranged informally

- Radial bands of feature planting

- Central pathway leading to Administration Entrance
